Early Alert Testing Christmas Closure

The last day of testing provided by the University is Wed 22 Dec and the first day of testing after Christmas is Wed 5 January 2022; it will still be possible to report LFD and NHS testing results. During this time the telephone booking service will not be available. Please be aware that online booking is generally the quickest way to obtain a test and should be used in the first instance.

Between Thursday 23 December and Tuesday 4 January, should you develop symptoms, you should book a free NHS test. Do not wait for the Early Alert Service to reopen (please note that although you may be asked for your NHS number, this is not required and will not prevent you from



booking.) Staff and students should continue to upload non-University results to EAS during the two-week period. Although the Early Alert Service will be paused, the Results Liaison Team will still be active. Visit the EAS webpage for more information.

You will still be able to collect LFD tests from the Lodge during the College closure period.
