College Procedure

If the harassment arises solely in the college environment or is by a member of college staff, please follow the college's procedures.

Criminal misconduct

If a criminal offence has been committed, the harassment Procedure may not be appropriate. These cases will include, but not be limited to, serious assault or threat of serious assault. Student members can seek advice from the Director of Student Welfare and Support Services office and/or approach the Police directly.
