JESUS COLLEGE ACCESS BURSARIES

Jesus College Access Bursaries are available to eligible UK and Republic of Ireland students *in addition to* the Oxford Bursaries* and government maintenance loans; they are **free grants** (so you do not have to pay the bursaries back after graduation) towards course-related costs. There is no separate application form to fill in – the College will use your Student Finance assessment to calculate whether you should receive one and how much you should be awarded if you are eligible. Access Bursaries are paid to you by the College. These bursaries are made possible by the generous donations from former students of the College.

UK students: The amount of financial support available depends on ‘residual household income’. The 2023-24 figures are below:

RESIDUAL HOUSEHOLD INCOME	JESUS COLLEGE ACCESS BURSARY
Up to £32,500	£950 per year
£32,501 – £42,875	£750 per year
£42,876 – £50,000	£650 per year
More than £42,875	£0

***Oxford Crankstart Bursaries** are provided by the University and Colleges. Eligible UK students will receive **up to £5,000** per year. There is no separate application form to fill in – the University will use your Student Finance assessment.

You must make sure you have applied for government support and agreed to share this information with your University in order to be considered for a bursary. Once the University has received the data they will send a letter to you; the first letters will be sent in September.
